All walkers are responsible for their own safety and accept that they take part in walks at their own risk.

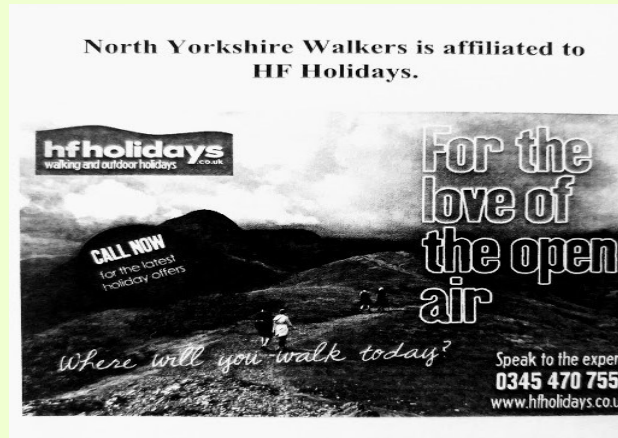
They should however:

Sunday 2nd January 2022 **Easy** **5 miles**

A circular walk from Thornton le Moor through Thornton Stud Farm on farm roads and fields.

Start: 10.00

Start at Thornton le Moor on the roadside near The Black Swan Inn DL7 9DN Grid ref: SE 392 881.

Sunday 9th January 2022 **Mod/Diff** **5 or 9.3 miles**
